Welcome to our PS 33, Chelsea Prep family! We cannot wait to meet all of you in September! Below is the requested list of supplies for Kindergarten. Please try to bring all supplies by the end of our first full week of school. We thank you all in advance for your dedication and support as we embark on our collaborative learning journey together!

KINDERGARTEN SUPPLIES:

- 4 **LARGE** Elmer's glue sticks
- 2 bottles of Elmer's clear glue
- 2 packages of regular post-it notes - any color
- 1 box of **LARGE** pencils with **NO ERASERS**
- 1 3-ring binder that fits 8 ½ x 11 paper with sleeve (1 or 1 ½ inch size)
- 2 boxes of crayola markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 3 paper towel rolls
- 4 **PLASTIC** , durable folders with pockets
- 3 containers of disinfectant wipes (Ex. Clorox or Lysol)
- 1 container of baby wipes
- 3 **LARGE** rolls of clear plastic packing tape (Scotch brand preferred)
- 1 liquid soap (Preferred brands: Method, 365, ECOS)
- 2 4-packs of large play-doh
- 2 packages of expo dry-erase markers (Primary colors preferred)
- 1 box of gallon ziploc bags
- 1 box of sandwich sized ziploc bags
- 1 box box of model magic
- 1 box of 12 black papermate flair felt tip pens, medium point
- 1-2 large poster board paper (any bright color)

Additionally:

- 1 change of clothes (shirt, underwear, socks, pants) to be kept in school in case of an accident. Place clothing in a plastic bag with your child's name on it.

- Your child should also bring their own water bottle with their name on it every day.

- **SNACK** - Although each class will handle snack differently, for the first week until we have our class list generated, please send in a healthy snack with your child.
