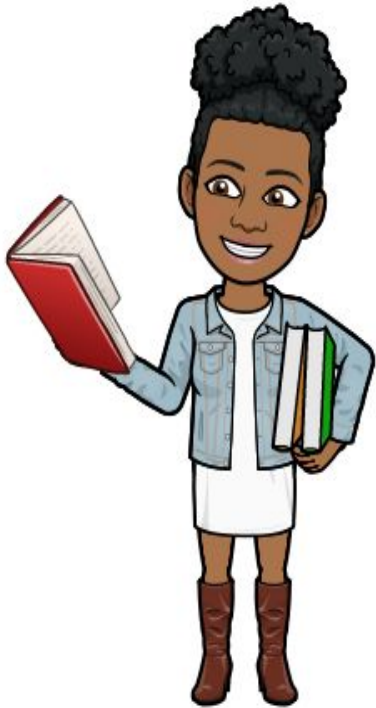

INTEGRATED APPROACH IN ACTION

Reading
