- Include characters
- Include the problem
- Include the solution
- Include the lesson

## Write to the Character

What would you tell the character?

- Write in letter style
- You can write about
  - The problem
  - The solution
  - Give advice
  - Give compliments
  - Make connections

## Change the Ending

How would you change the ending?

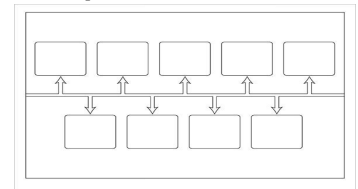
- Rewrite the ending
